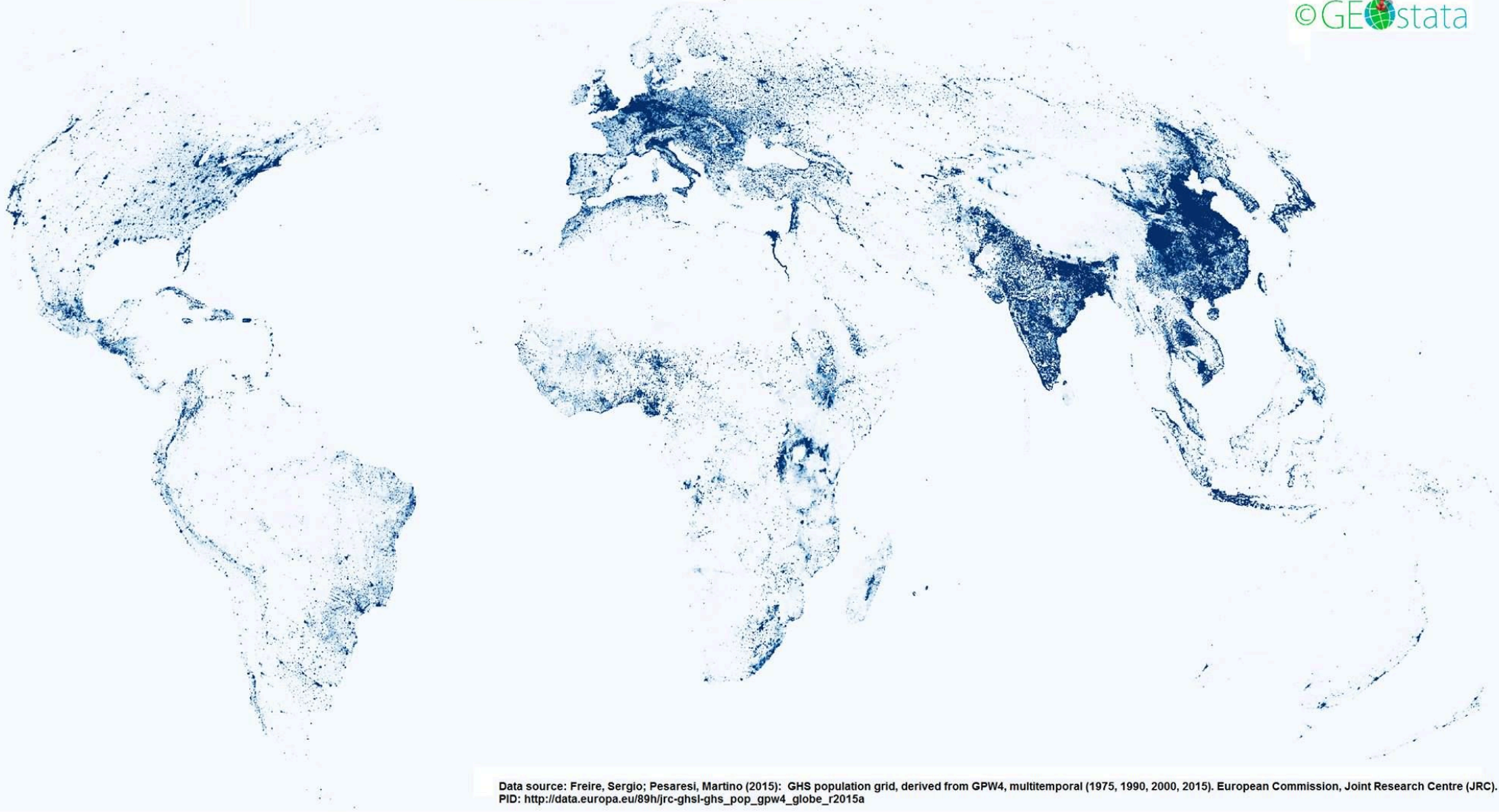

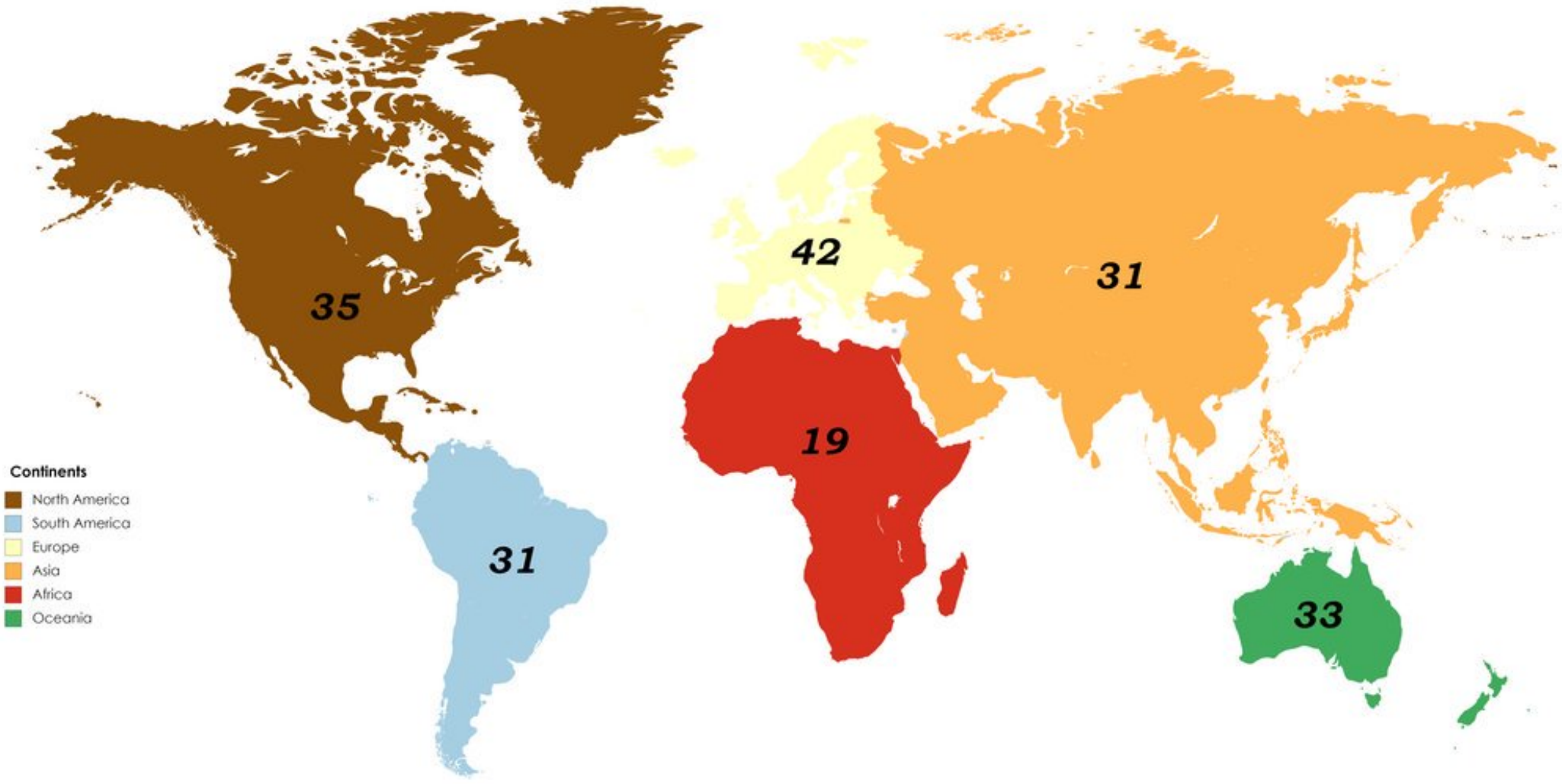

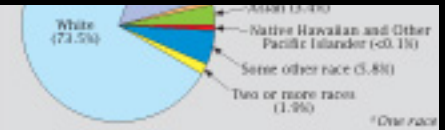
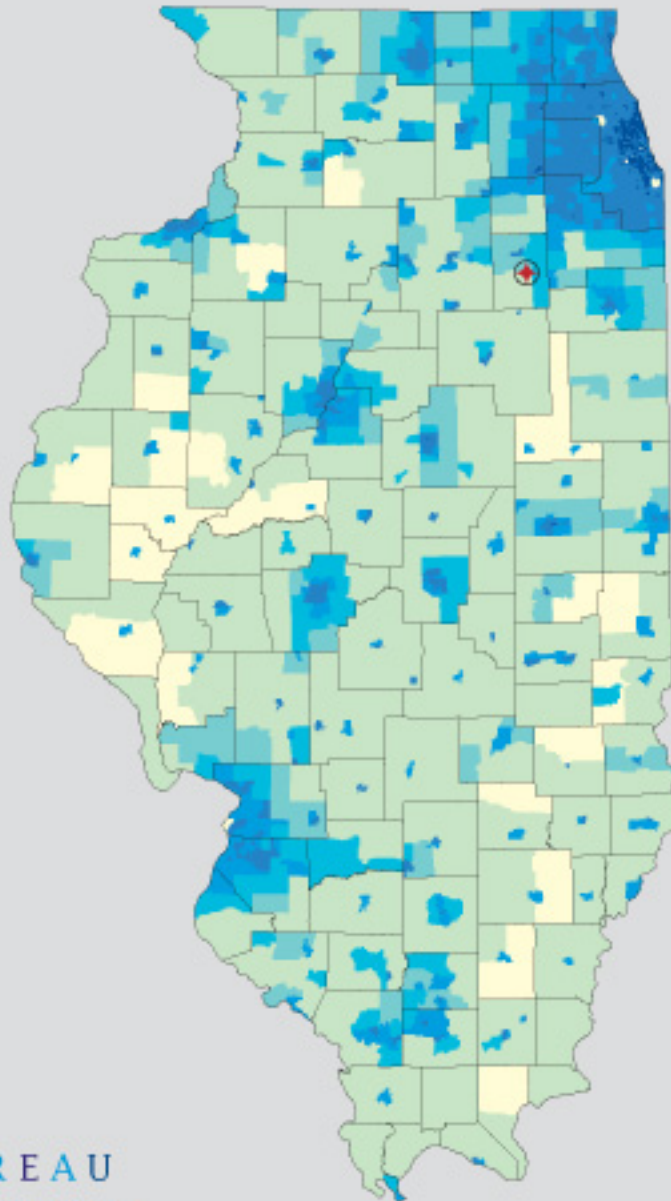

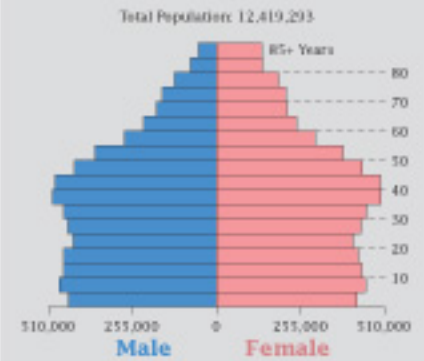

Hispanic or Latino (of any race) makes up **12.3%** of the state population.

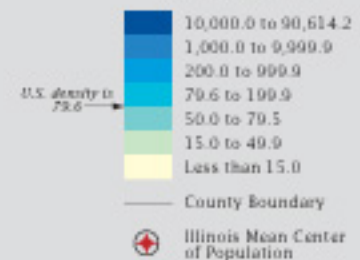
Population by Sex and Age



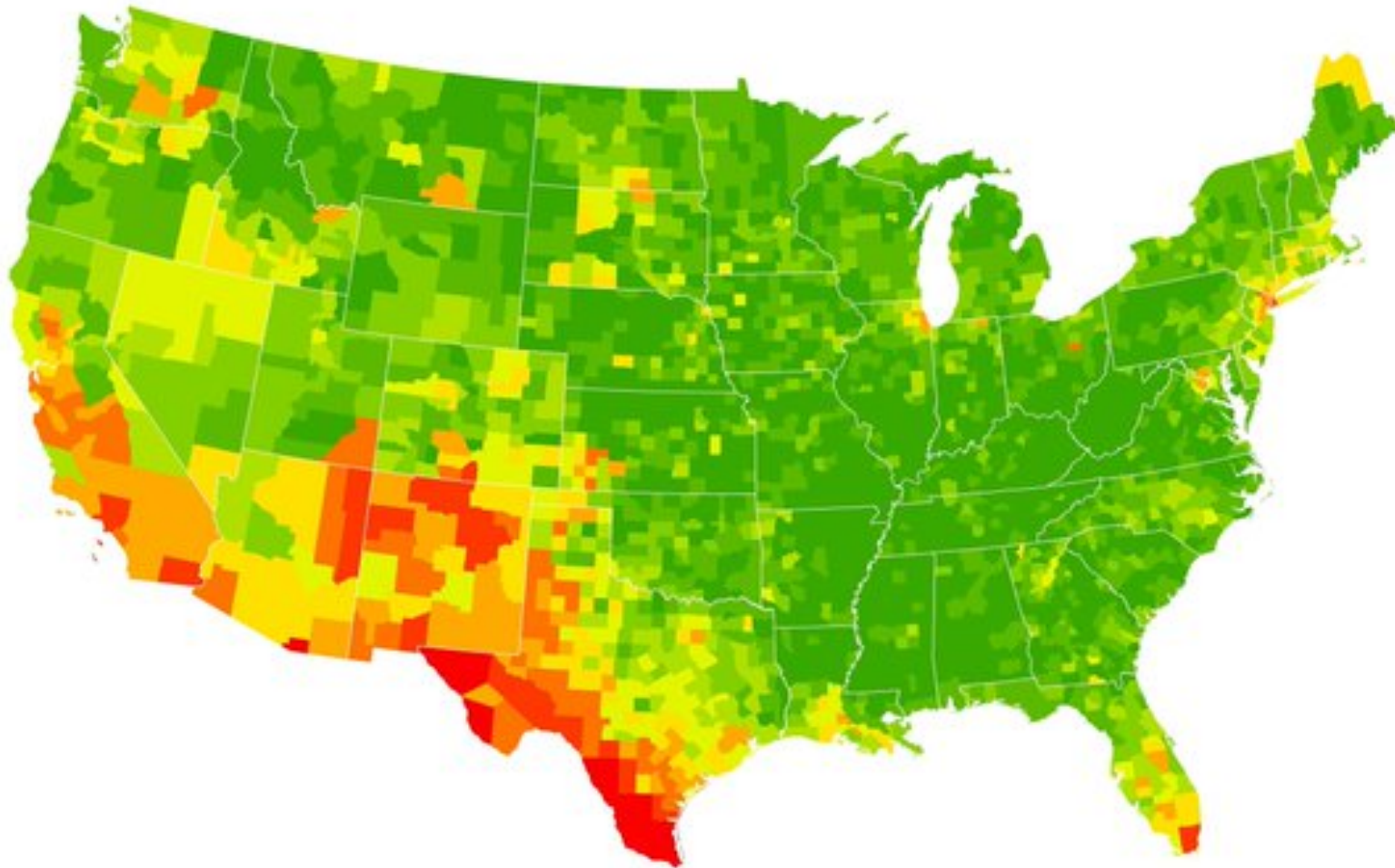
Housing Tenure

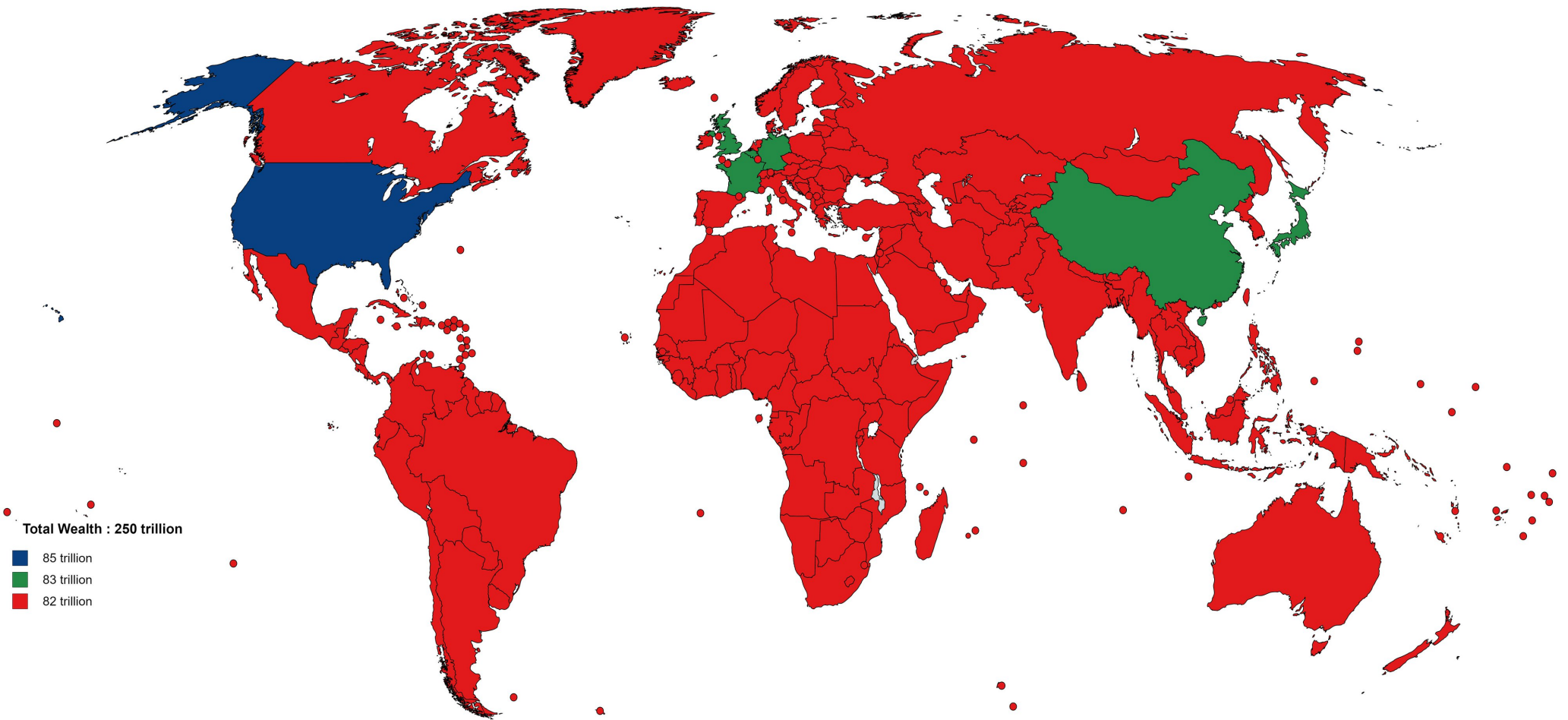

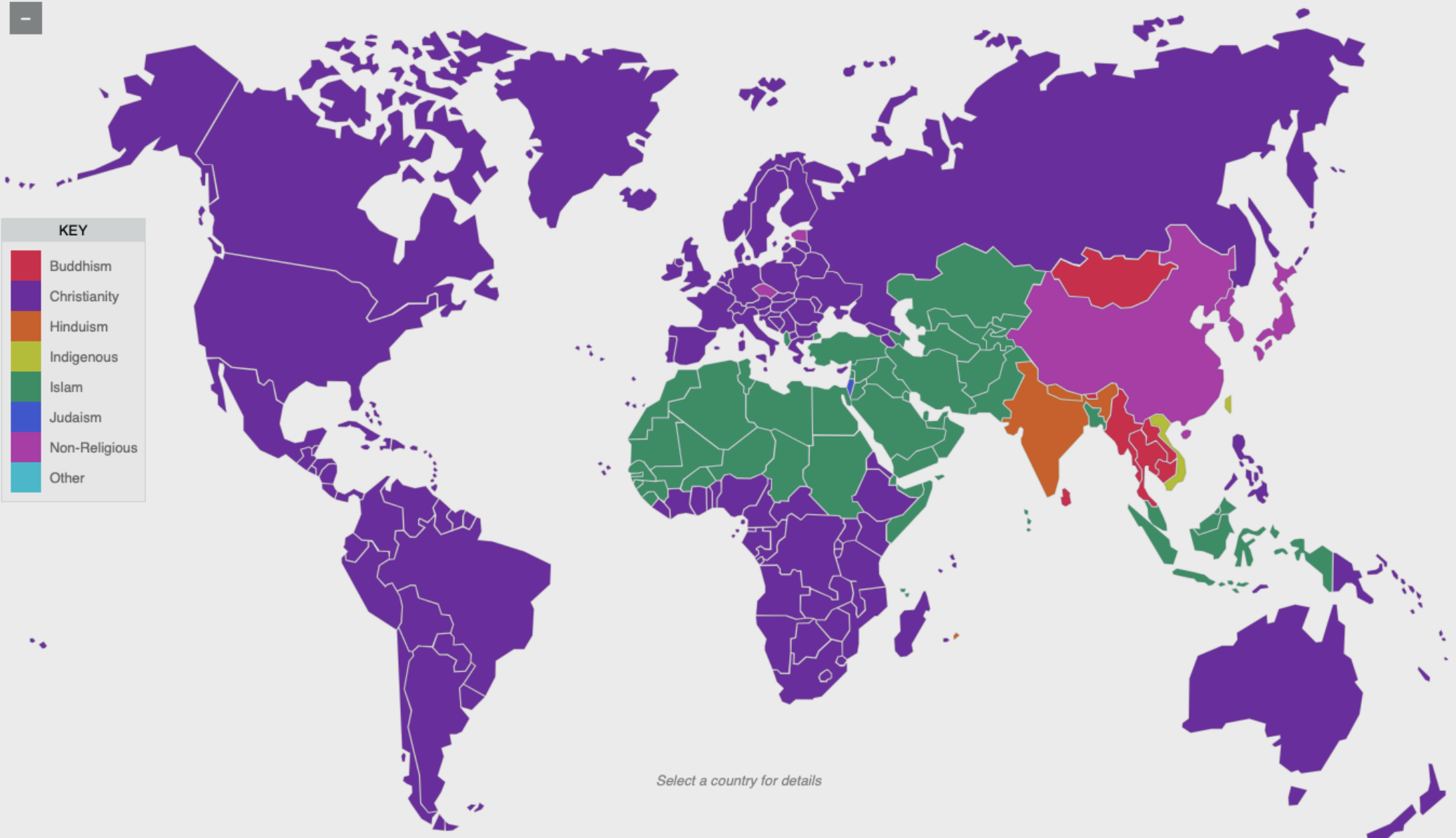
