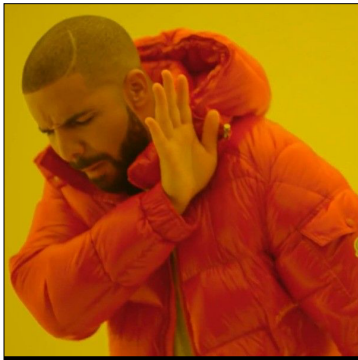


# Citing Your Sources:

## Introduce - Cite - Explain.


