




Let's Investigate Some of Our Assumptions


We'll dive deeper into mass incarceration stats, but here's a quick preview of looking at it through a racial lens




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








Does your race have an affect on whether people will hire you?







Is it illegal for schools to be segregated? Let's Take a Look!










Is it illegal for schools to be segregated?

It's only illegal for schools to be explicitly stating they're segregating school by race. There is no punishment for lack of integration in schools.




This is the opposite stat. So you want a lower score!

Is racism a bigger problem in the South?

Think of this like a % on a test. 100% is perfect integration. 0% is perfect segregation.


Identity with a group, usually based on physical appearance, but family lineage also plays a role

RACE IS A SOCIAL CONSTRUCT, NOT A SCIENTIFIC CLASSIFICATION.

An idea that has been created by people to help us understand the world. Not always based on science / reality



The Creation of White

Prior to American slavery of Africans, few people identified as "white". They were "English", "French", "German", etc...

Whiteness was created as an opposition to blackness - were you eligible for slavery or free from slavery?



1790 American laws are some of the first times people were referred to as "White"


