Untaught History: Tulsa, Oklahoma



Black Wall Street



In 1921, a white mob attacked the residents of the Greenwood Neighborhood

Thousands of white citizens attacked the neighborhood, burning an area bigger than 35 city blocks! Over 1,200 houses were burned and/or looted.

The National Guard came in & detained around 6,000 Black residents.

Dozens died. Tulsa has fully never recovered (to this day).

In 1921, a white mob attacked the residents of the Greenwood Neighborhood

The city said about 20 black residents were killed.

Over the decades, government investigations have revealed that between 100 & 300 black residents were killed.

More than 8,000 additional people were made homeless.



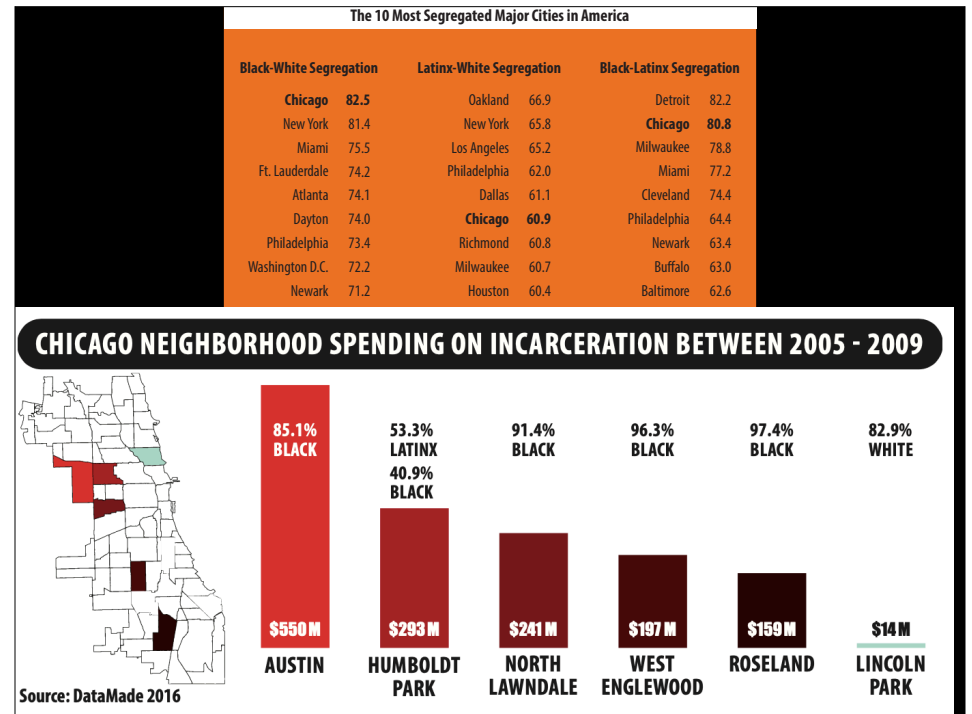
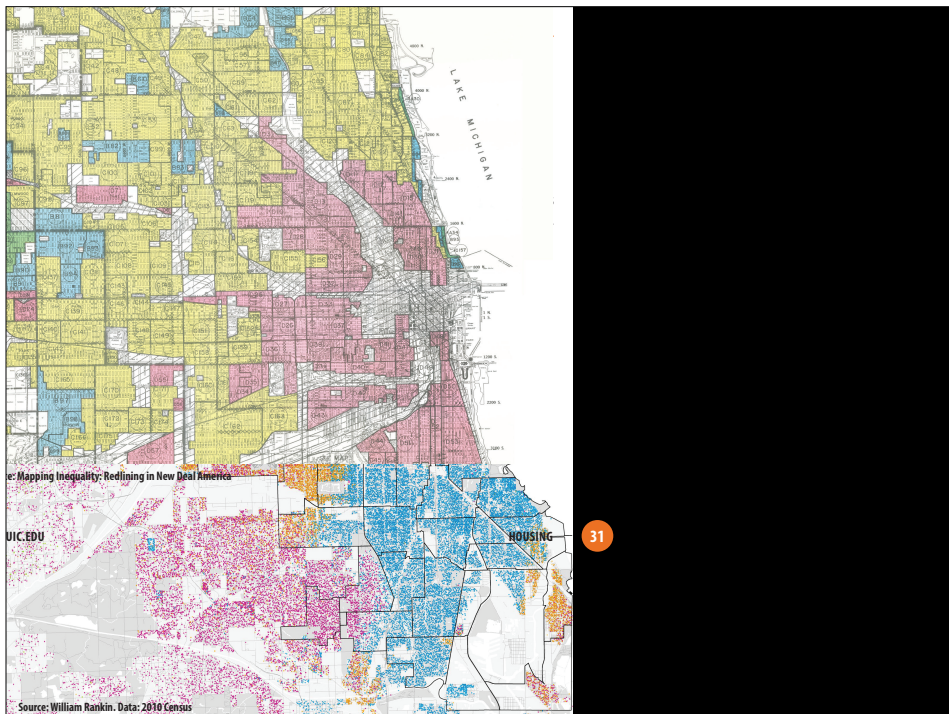
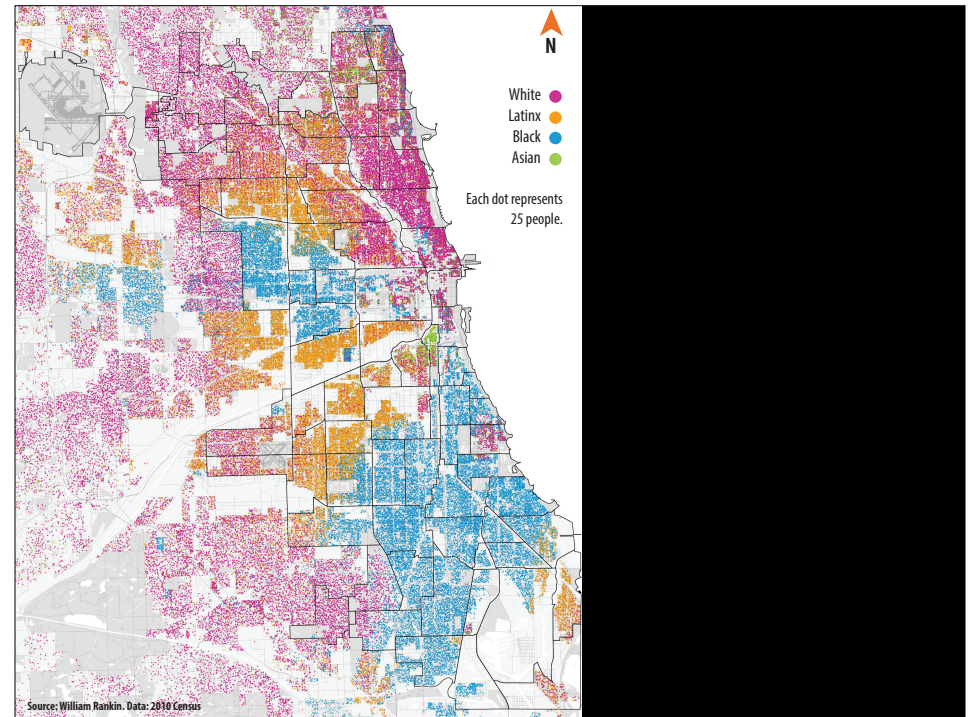
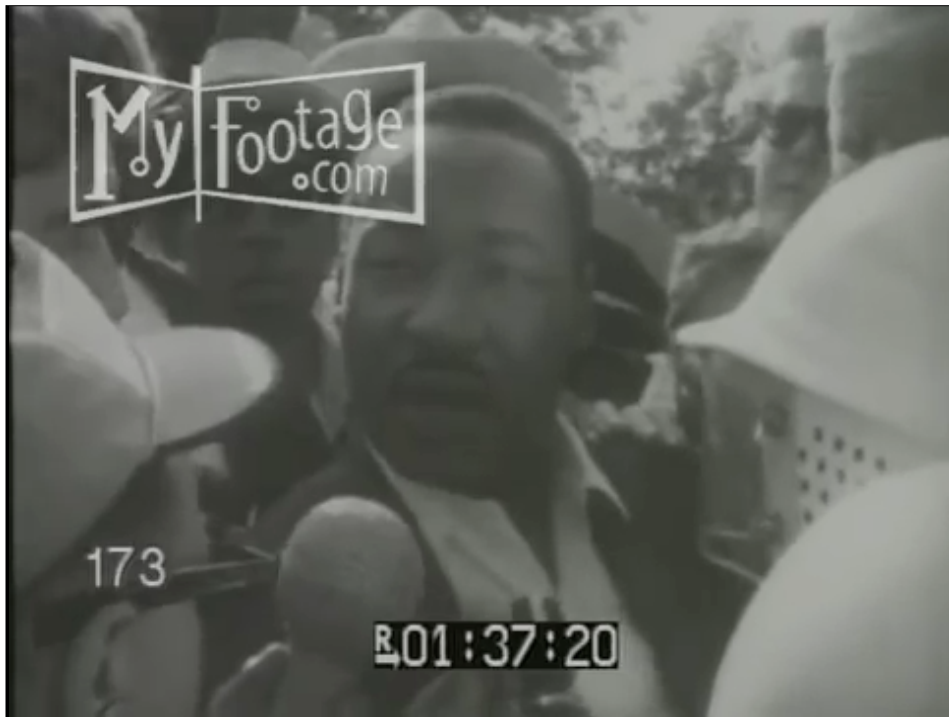
